Your Nuisance Diary PLEASE READ THE FOLLOWING GUIDANCE CAREFULLY

- 1. It is possible that the information you provide to us could be used in legal action by the council.
- 2. Your diary may be used as evidence in any court proceedings. In such circumstances, the details you provide may be disclosed to a third party including the person(s) you have complained about. However, signatures and telephone numbers will not be disclosed.
- 3. Be aware that the council may be required to disclose your diary to other statutory agencies (e.g. police, social services and H.M. Revenue & Customs) for the prevention of crime and disorder.
- 4. Your diary will be used to assess your complaint and should therefore contain as much detail as possible. Each incident that troubles you should be recorded on a separate line
- 5. You should include the start and finish times of each incident.
- 6. You should identify the way in which the incident affects your normal activities. It is better if this is related to an easily recognisable activity in which you are trying to engage at the time of each incidence (see the example on the first diary sheet).
- 7. You should sign each page.
- 8. Please be aware that the record sheet carries a declaration of the accuracy of the records kept, which must be signed, and that such records may be presented as evidence if legal action is taken against any persons causing a nuisance.
- 9. If you have any queries about how to fill in the record sheets, please contact the investigating officer.
