

NOTICE OF REVIEW OF POLLING DISTRICTS AND POLLING PLACES

Newcastle-under-Lyme Borough Council is conducting a review of polling districts and polling places in accordance with the Representation of the People Act 1983 (as amended by the Electoral Registration and Administration Act 2013).

The (Acting) Returning Officer (ARO) for the future Parliamentary constituencies of Newcastle-under-Lyme will comment on the proposals. Those representations will be published on the Council's website and Castle House (Council Offices) in accordance with the timetable set out below.

In addition, representations are invited from electors within the Borough or the Staffordshire Parliamentary constituencies, elected members, local political parties and organisations that have expertise in relation to access for people with different types of disability.

Persons or bodies making representations should, if possible, give alternative places that may be used as polling places.
