Decision Statement Regarding the Borough Council's Consideration of the 25 September 2025 Referendum result – Notice of Making of the Neighbourhood Plan pursuant to Section 38A of the Planning and Compulsory Purchase Act 2004, as amended by the Neighbourhood Planning Act 2017

Decision

Newcastle-under-Lyme Borough Council decided by delegated authority of Simon McEneny, Deputy Chief Executive, in consultation with Councillor Andrew Fear — Cabinet Portfolio Holder — Strategic Planning on 26 September 2025 to make the Audley Rural Neighbourhood Plan under Section 38A (4) of the Planning and Compulsory Purchase Act 2004 (as amended). The Audley Rural Neighbourhood Plan now forms part of the Development Plan for Newcastle-under-Lyme Borough.

Reasons for decision:

The Audley Rural Neighbourhood Plan meets the 'Basic Conditions' and its promotion process is compliant with legal and procedural requirements. Paragraphs 38A(4)(a) and (6) of the Planning and Compulsory Purchase Act 2004 (as amended) requires the Council to make a Neighbourhood Plan if more than half of those voting in the referendum have voted in favour of the Plan being used to help decide planning applications in the area, unless the Council consider that the 'making' of the plan would breach, or would otherwise be incompatible with, any EU obligation or any of the Convention rights (within the meaning of the Human Rights Act 1998). The Council is not of that opinion.

On 25 September 2025 the Audley Rural Neighbourhood Plan was subject to a local referendum which returned a majority vote in favour of using the Audley Rural Neighbourhood Plan to decide planning applications within the Audley Neighbourhood Area.

Upon declaration of this result the Audley Rural Neighbourhood Plan now forms part of the statutory development plan for Newcastle-under-Lyme Borough Council.
