Application for the designation of Keele Parish as a Neighbourhood Area

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that an application to designate a Neighbourhood Area has been received by Newcastle-Under-Lyme Borough Council. The application has been made by Keele Parish Council under Section 61G of the Town and Country Planning Act 1990.

The area applied to be designated comprises the entire area of Keele Parish. A copy of the application letter and a map of the area can be viewed on the Borough Council website at www.newcastle-staffs.gov.uk/neighbourhoodplanning or at the Guildhall, High Street, Newcastle-under-Lyme, ST5 1PW (opening hours are Monday to Friday 9am to 5pm).

Please note that of the 1st of April 2016 the Keele Parish Boundary was brought in line with the Keele electoral ward boundary. The proposed Neighbourhood Area reflects this boundary change.
