Any challenge must be made on the grounds that either the document has not been prepared in accordance with the Planning and Compulsory Purchase Act 2004 or alternatively that a requirement of the Act or associated Regulations have not been complied with.

Any such application must be made no later than 3 months after the date of adoption specified above.
