Application for the designation of the Parish of Kidsgrove as the area for a Neighbourhood Plan. In accordance with the Town and Country Planning Act 1990 (as amended) and the Neighbourhood Planning Regulations 2012, I wish to lodge a formal application to Newcastle Borough Council for Kidsgrove Parish to be designated as a neighbourhood area. The Town Council resolved on 15th August 2019 to develop a Neighbourhood Plan for Kidsgrove Parish in accordance with Neighbourhood Planning (General Regulations) 2012.

The Neighbourhood Area:

The Town Council further resolved that the area considered to be the appropriate designated area in accordance with Part 2 of the 2012 Regulations is the area within the boundary of the Civil Parish of Kidsgrove comprising the four Wards: Kidsgrove and Ravenscliffe, Talke and Butt Lane, Harding's Wood and Newchapel and Mow Cop.

A map showing the boundary of the Parish and the area covered by the Neighbourhood Plan is attached.

Kidsgrove Town Council as a relevant body.

The Town Council confirms that it is a relevant body for the purposes of Section 61G of the Town and Country Planning Act 1990 (as amended) and accordingly applies for the Parish to be designated the neighbourhood area for the purposes of the Neighbourhood Plan.
